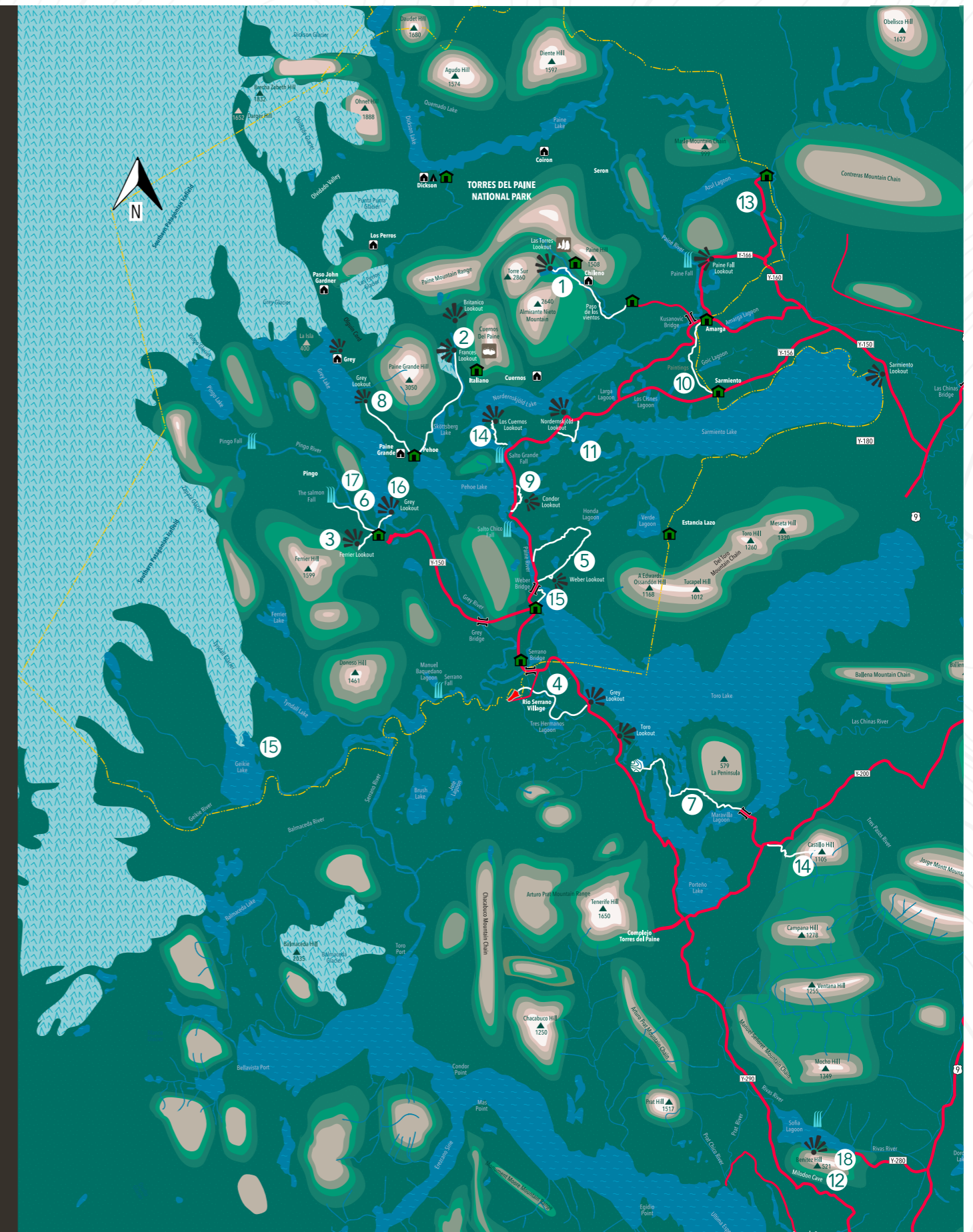
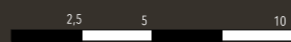

1. Base of the Towers

This route is part of the renowned "W" trekking circuit within Torres del Paine National Park. Known for its demanding nature, it lives up to its reputation due to the steep slopes and challenging terrain, offering open views, if the weather allows it. Located in the eastern part of the park in the Ascencio Valley, it serves as a natural entry point for an intense and progressive hike, dotted with numerous scenic viewpoints overlooking rivers, streams, and mountain slopes.

Exposed to granite blocks shaped by the harsh Patagonian climate. Upon reaching the Towers Lookout, hikers are rewarded with one of the most iconic views in this region—a breathtaking amphitheater of rocky peaks and glaciers.

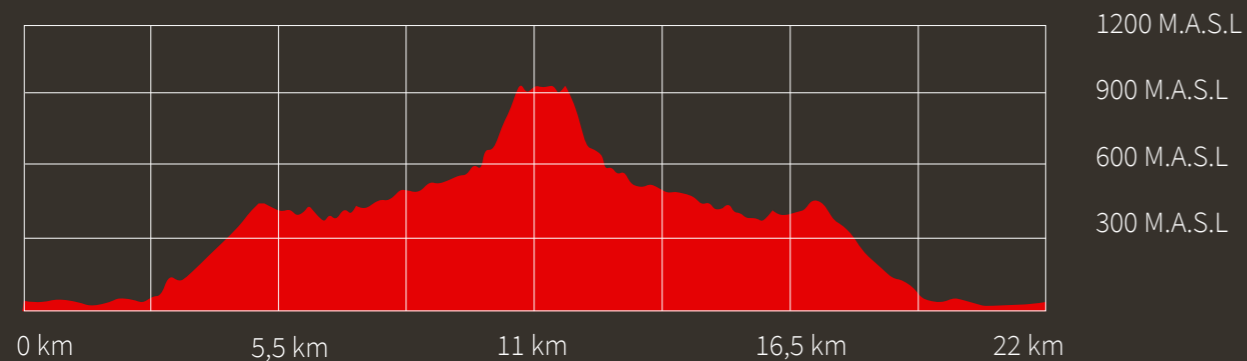

2.French Valley

Renowned for its striking trail in the National Park. It is a must-do for hiking enthusiasts in excellent physical condition. The adventure begins at Pudeto Dock, where we board a catamaran navigating the turquoise waters of Lake Pehoe towards the base of Cerro Paine Grande.

The route ascends through an ancient glacial moraine and a wooded valley, culminating at the French Lookout with a close encounter with the Horns. Immerse yourself in the amphitheater of Torres del Paine, surrounded by glaciers and towering granite walls.

***Please note that this excursion includes a catamaran crossing of Lake Pehoé, operated by an external company with limited availability, especially during high season. The catamaran ticket involves an additional cost per person and is nominative and date-specific. We kindly recommend informing our reservations team at the time of booking if you wish to include this service, so we can do our best to secure availability, although this cannot be guaranteed.**

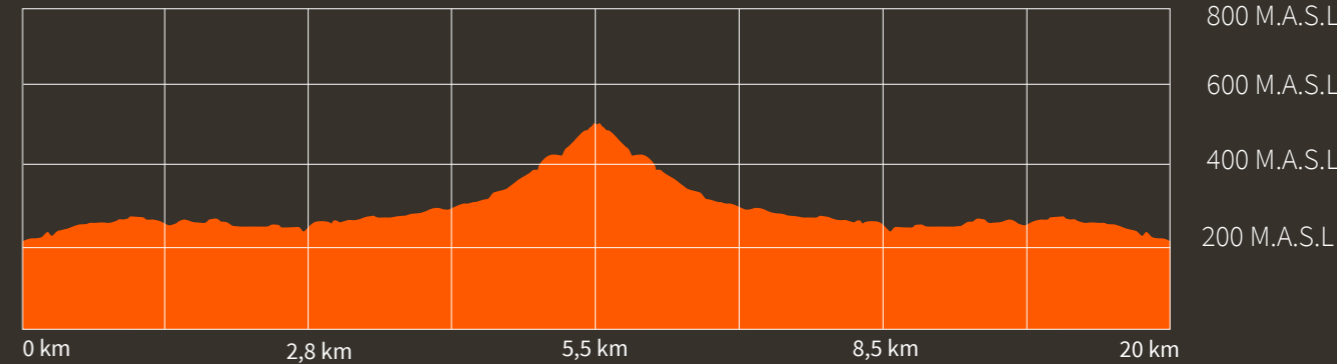

3.Ferrier Lookout

Providing expansive landscape views of the place whenever weather conditions permit it starts from the Grey Park Ranger Station, the adventure begins with a challenging ascent up one of the steepest slopes on the park's western side. The trail winds through dense Pre-Andean shrub and ancient lenga forests. The exposed rock lookout serves as a rewarding endpoint, providing views of the Paine Massif, Sierra Baguales, the Southern Patagonian Ice Field, lakes, rivers, and the argentine steppe's expansive pampas. The experience is enhanced by strong winds adding to the adventure and the open scenery.

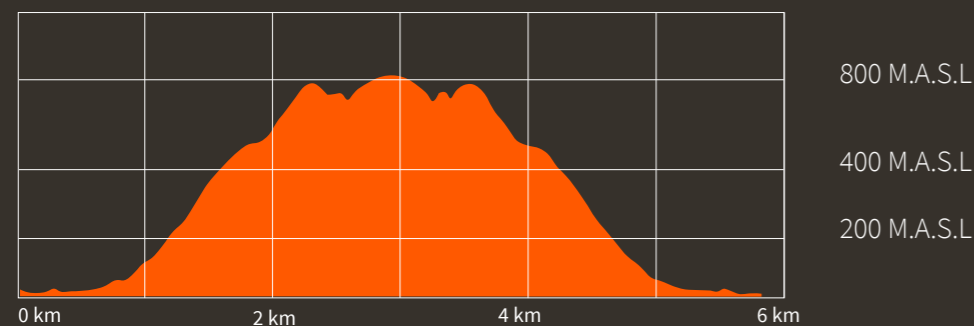

4. Macizo Paine

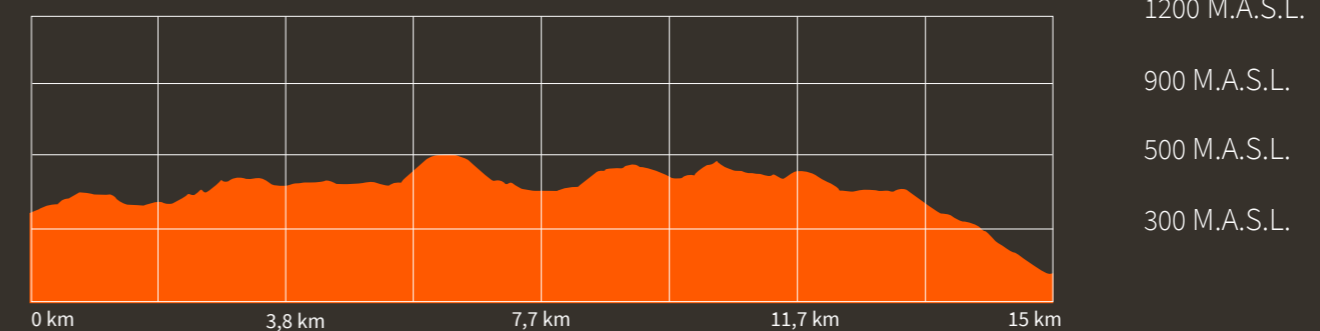
This excursion, exclusive to Patagonia Camp, is a private experience limited to the group and guide. Starting with a scenic 20-minute drive from the hotel to the Grey Lookout and then we ascend along a trail that offers panoramic views over Torres del Paine. Following winding paths through ancient forests and lagoons, we're treated to breathtaking views of the Paine Massif, Grey Glacier, a portion of the South Patagonian Ice Field, and the Serrano Valley. Descending through a series of hidden lagoons, we traverse a ravine rich with pre-andean shrub and lenga forests, all against the backdrop of the Serrano Valley.

5.Toro Heights

Located just in between Patagonia Camp and the Paine Massif, can be found this secret jewel for trekking inside the park. A steady uphill will take us to the cornices of the Toro Heights, where we hike across a deep and pristine lenga forest away from the crowds of popular W circuit, going by small lagoons reflecting of the majestic geological formations. Experience the pure, lonely and wild Patagonia, with its varied views and changing vegetation.

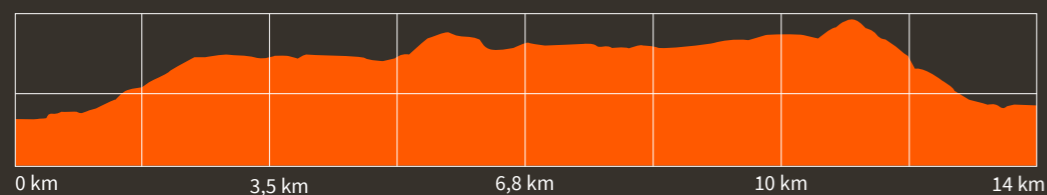

6. Pingo Valley - Grey Beach

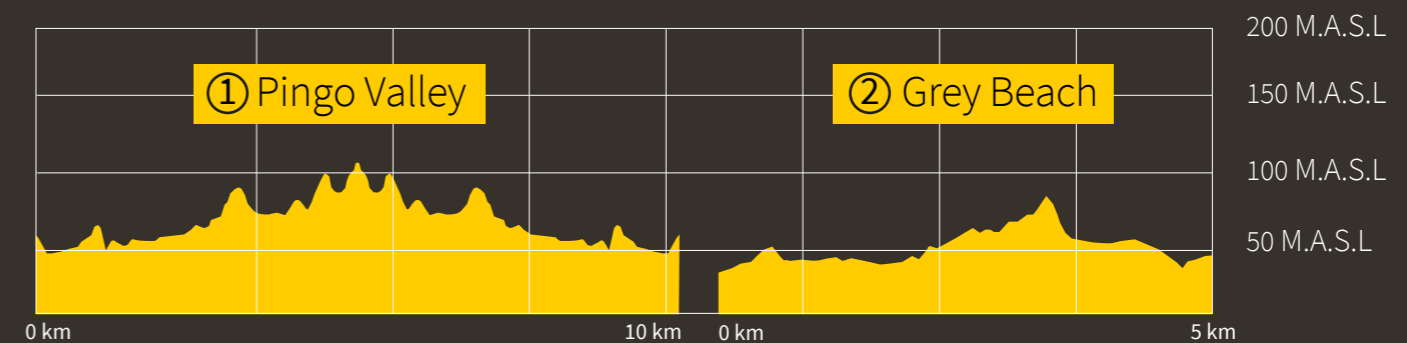
Ideal for forest tranquility seekers, this excursion is just an hour west of the park, at the banks of Pingo River. We traverse shrubland and Magellanic forest, enjoying views of the river's meanders and Paine Grande Hill. Moving on, we pass through grazing areas for park rangers' horses, then enter a lenga and coihue tree forest. The first part ends at a salmon frequented stream, offering occasional wildlife sightings. Next, we cross the Pingo River to reach an ancient lenga forest by Lake Grey, views of the Paine Massif and, if weather's good, distant icebergs, followed by a 45 mt. ascent to a Grey Lake viewpoint.

7.Los Maitenes Peninsula

Completely exclusive from Patagonia Camp. After a 40 minute drive to the “El Bote Bay” we will start our walk through deciduous and evergreen Magellanic forests and will have the privilege of observing the only native forest of the mayten tree to be found in Chilean South Patagonia and also other species that have migrated from the National Park to quieter sectors. This is truly an idyllic setting with beautiful views of the Paine Massif and the lakes of Toro, Maravilla and Porteño and guests will be able to connect with the wild and solitary nature of the Patagonian ecosystem. The excursion ends walking back to Hotel Patagonia Camp.

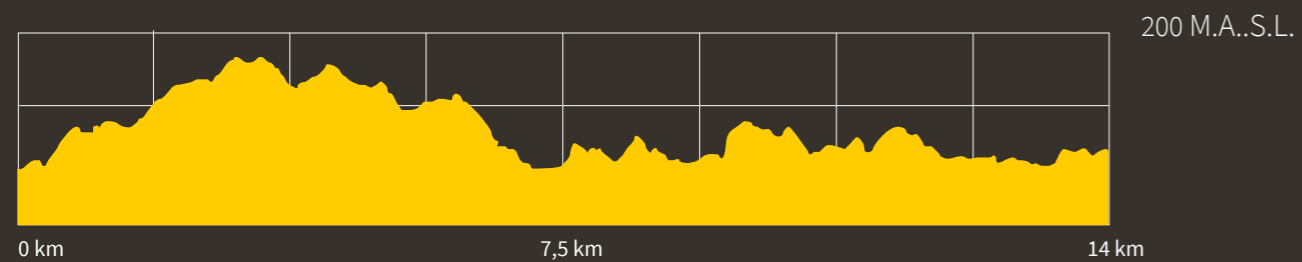

8. Grey Trek

The trail to the Grey Lookout is situated on the western side of the “W” circuit, traversing the slopes of Paine Grande Hill after a 30-minute boat journey across Lake Pehoe from the Pudeto Sector. Initially, we traverse a basin of sedimentary rock until reaching the western face of Paine Grande Hill. The lookout offers a panoramic view of Lake Grey and its imposing glacier, visible in the distance whenever the weather allows and a taste of how wild and prevailing are the forces of nature in Southern Patagonia. It sometimes affords views of icebergs across the lake.

***Please note that this excursion includes a catamaran crossing of Lake Pehoé, operated by an external company with limited availability, especially during high season. The catamaran ticket involves an additional cost per person and is nominative and date-specific. We kindly recommend informing our reservations team at the time of booking if you wish to include this service, so we can do our best to secure availability, although this cannot be guaranteed.**

***After completing the hike, at Paine Grande refuge there is a minimum wait of 1 hour and 30 minutes for the earliest arrival in the afternoon of the catamaran for the return journey across Lake Pehoe.**

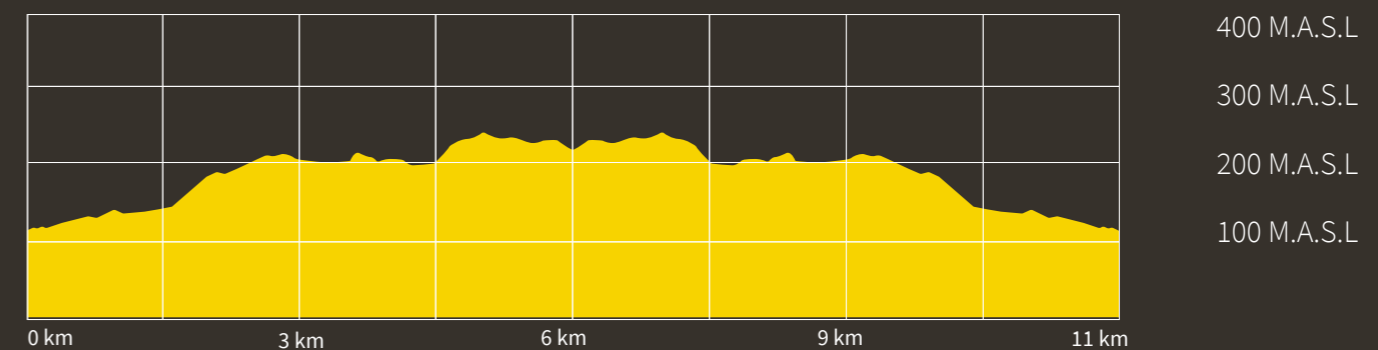

9.Miradores

Includes two of the most emblematic icons of the Paine Massif. During the first part we will walk through a sector with strong winds in the direction of the well-known Salto Grande waterfall meeting the strong currents that connect two lakes of turquoise tones. Then we will go to reach the lookout that allows us to observe up close the mythical Paine Horns. We will travel by vehicle to the Pehoe sector, have lunch and then in search to do the second hike that climbs steadily up to a conglomerate rock summit that is home to the nests of condors offering occasional wildlife sightings and which offers impressive views of Pehoe Lake, the last mountains in the South Patagonian Ice Field and Sierra Baguales.

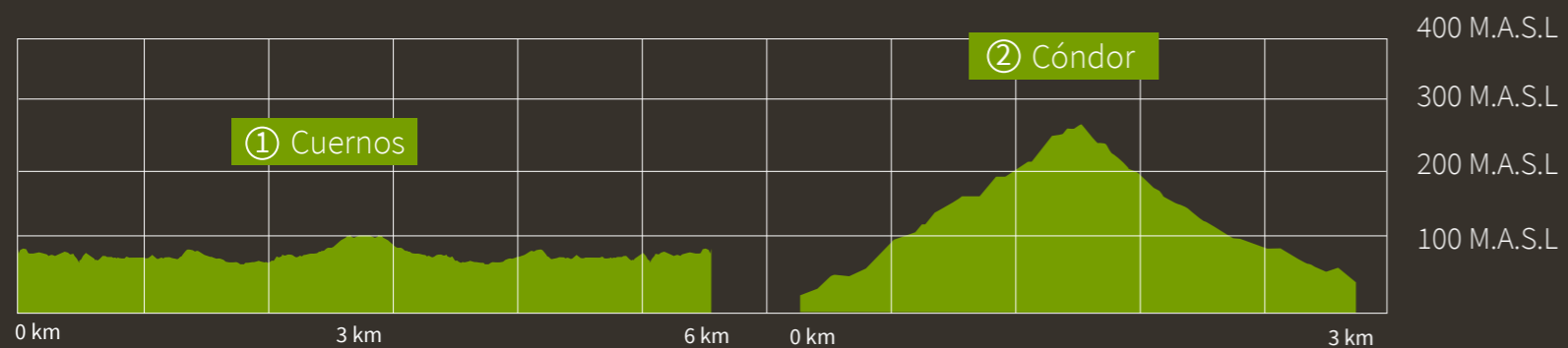

10. Historical Patagonia

This excursion takes place in the eastern sector of the National Park, known for its rich history and cultural significance. It features conglomerate rocks with ancient cave paintings, created thousands of years ago by nomads of the Aonikenk people. Participants will enjoy an educational hike focused on culture, history, and the rock art of the Aonikenk. While wildlife sightings are possible, the emphasis is on exploring the region's historical heritage and understanding animal behavior.

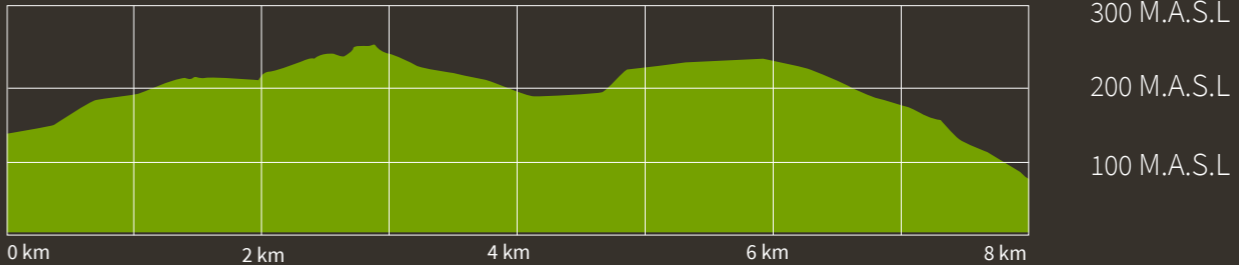
In the last part of the trip, we will visit the Laguna Azul area, offering a unique perspective of the iconic Paine Towers amidst the natural beauty of the place.

11.Sarmiento Lake

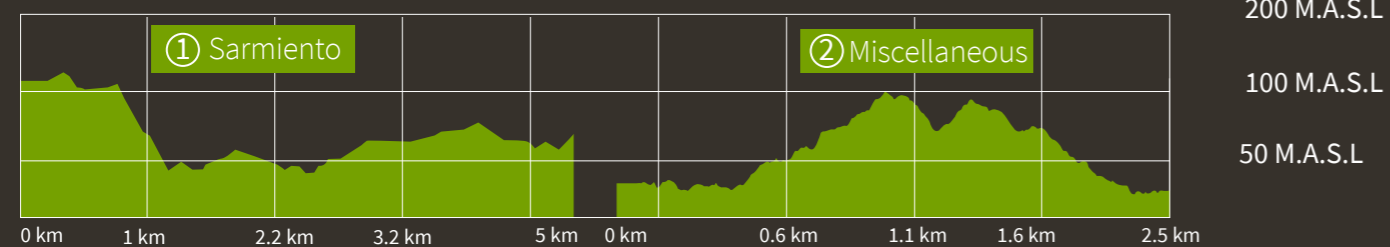
Explore the great Sarmiento Lake, a paradise of geological formations and ancient life forms like cyanobacteria. Meet the first forms of life on our planet. Our journey also includes a hike along the shores of El Toro Lake, near the park administration area. The Miscellaneous trail begins at the historic Weber Bridge, leading through plains and Magellanic forest rich in ñirres. After a brief ascent, enjoy breathtaking views of Paine River, El Toro Lake, and the confluence of Serrano and Grey Rivers. Discover the vast Patagonian steppe and native orchids blooming in spring (October-November).

12.The Milodon Cave

A visit to the Milodon Cave is an optimal choice for a calm day. This half-day excursion includes exploration of several caves within this Natural Monument, conveniently located near Puerto Natales town. The journey around Benitez Hill offers insights into a site rich in historical significance for the region.

The itinerary includes visits to 3 caves. These caves used to contain artifacts from the earliest inhabitants of the Steppe, including cave paintings and fossil remains of megafauna like the Milodon Sloth, Sabre Toothed Tiger and Hippidion Saldiasi horse. The region, chosen by the Aonikenk culture, boasts exceptional geological formations and open views of the Last Hope fjörd.

13.Scenic Paine

This is designed for those who prefer not to walk long distances in the National Park but still want to explore it by vehicle to capture views and create lasting memories of its landscapes. During the excursion, we will drive along the scenic roads of the National Park, stopping at several viewpoints in search of unforgettable landscapes. Depending on the weather, we will explore the eastern and western parts of the reserve. This allows us to experience steppe landscapes, lakes, and mountains, passing through the Magellanic forest and the areas around the ice fields.

The excursion is easy and involves minimal walking to reach key photo spots and learn about the diverse wildlife and geological formation of Southern Patagonia.

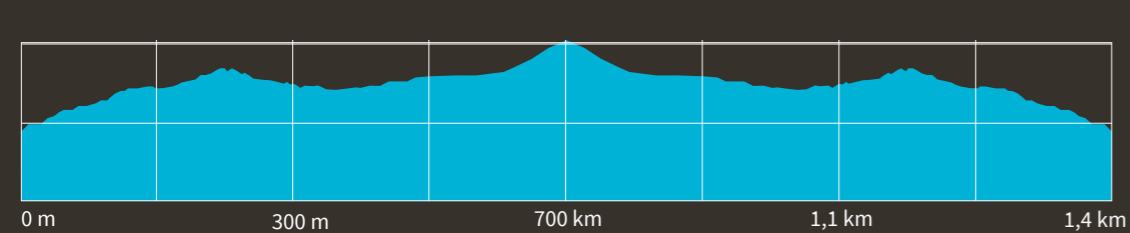

14.Horns Lookout

We will walk through an area that is usually exposed to strong winds towards the famous Salto Grande Waterfall, where we will encounter the intense currents that connect two turquoise lakes as our first official stop, then continue on to the imposing Cuernos viewpoint, enjoy the panoramic view, and then return along the same path.

The short hike includes some sections of stairs and leads to viewpoints.

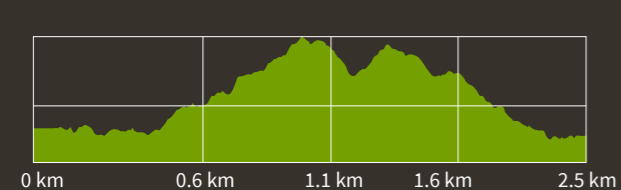

16. Grey Beach

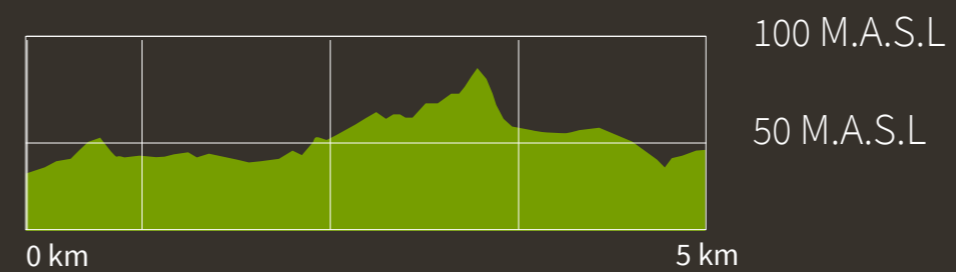
We crossed the Pingo River to reach an ancient lenga forest by Grey Lake, with views of the Paine Massif and, weather permitting, distant icebergs. The hike culminates with a 45-meter climb to a Grey Lake viewpoint, after which we began the return journey to the van along the same trail.

17.Pingo Valley

Ideal for those seeking the tranquility of the forest, this excursion is located just one hour west of the park, on the banks of the Pingo River. We hike through scrubland and Magellanic forests, enjoying views of the river's meanders and Cerro Paine Grande. We continue past grazing areas for the park rangers' horses, and then enter a forest of lenga and coihue trees. The first part ends at a stream frequented by salmon, offering occasional wildlife sightings.

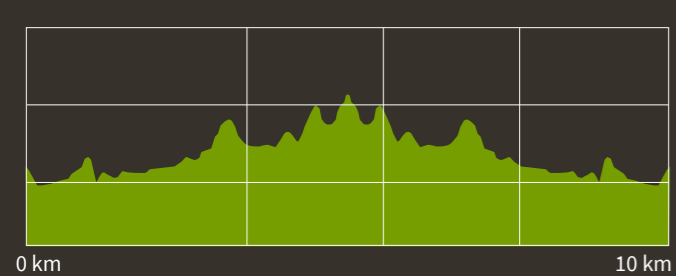
